2. Advise on his report of any other item which may need attention in the not too distant future.
3. Advise our maintenance staff on correct maintenance procedures and on operational practices, which, in his opinion, add to the efficient operation of the equipment.

A copy of the completed Service Checklist is to be supplied at the end of his visit.

We recommend all balers up to the size of 500 kg to be serviced once per annum but suggest that the larger balers and compactors (from 500kg and up) be maintained twice per annum.
